## Throwback on 30 years of international cooperation

Air knows no borders and climate change is a global issue that all countries are facing. That is why ATMO Grand Est, formerly ASPA, Air Lorraine and Atmo Champagne-Ardenne, has been

working for more than 30 years with foreign partners to improve air quality beyond borders, whether it is on a transboundary, European or international level.

## CROSS-BORDER PROJECTS AND PARTNERSHIPS

Bordered by Belgium, Luxemburg, Germany and Switzerland, its 760 kilometers of borders make the Grand Est region the leading cross-border region in metropolitan France. This situation allows ATMO Grand Est to work for more than thirty years in cross-border cooperation and to be a pilot or partner of many projects on several areas, largely thanks to the co-financing of INTERREG programs. The association also takes part in cross-border discussions within the bodies of these cooperation areas. In the Upper Rhine, it has been a member of the Air Quality Expert Group as well as the Environment Working Group of the Franco-German-Swiss Upper Rhine Conference since 2000. In the Greater Region, it has been leading the Sub-Working Group “Cross-border networking of air quality data” since 2017 and it is a member of the Environment Working Group of the Summit of the Greater Region. These exchange meetings allow each member to share the air situation of their region including remaining black spots, technical aspects of monitoring, actions and plans implemented to reduce impacts, all with a view of sharing experiences.

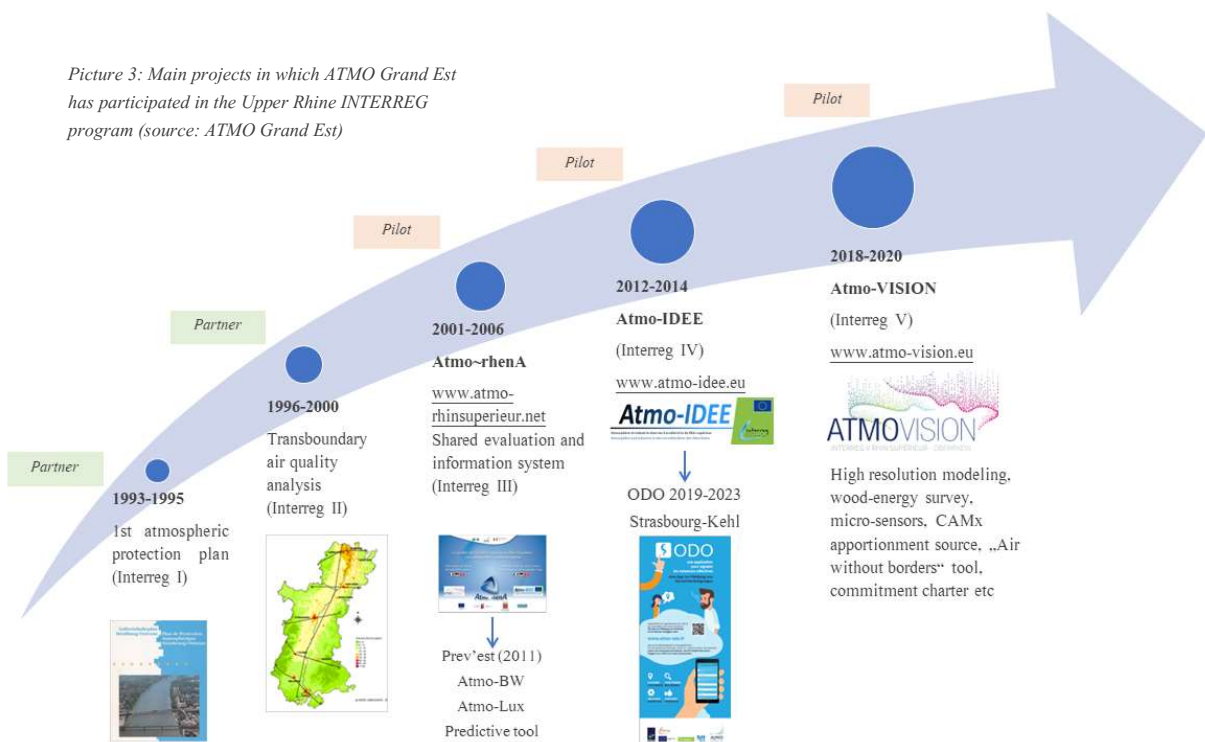


Picture 1: The Grand Est and INTERREG programs (source: French Culture Ministry)

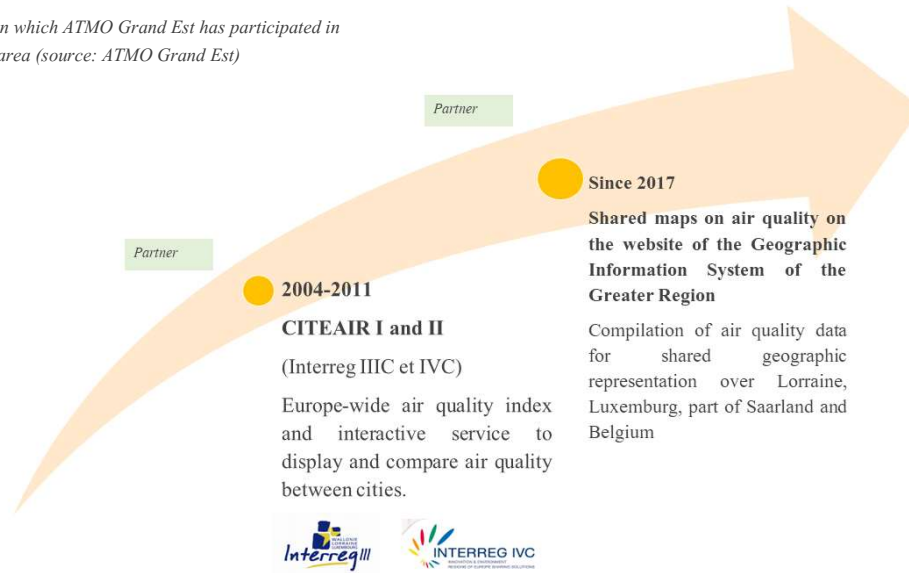


Picture 2: Logos of the Greater Region Summit and the Upper Rhine Conference


ATMO Grand Est has also been a partner in other cross-border projects, whether at the level of the Greater Region or the Upper Rhine, or interregional projects.



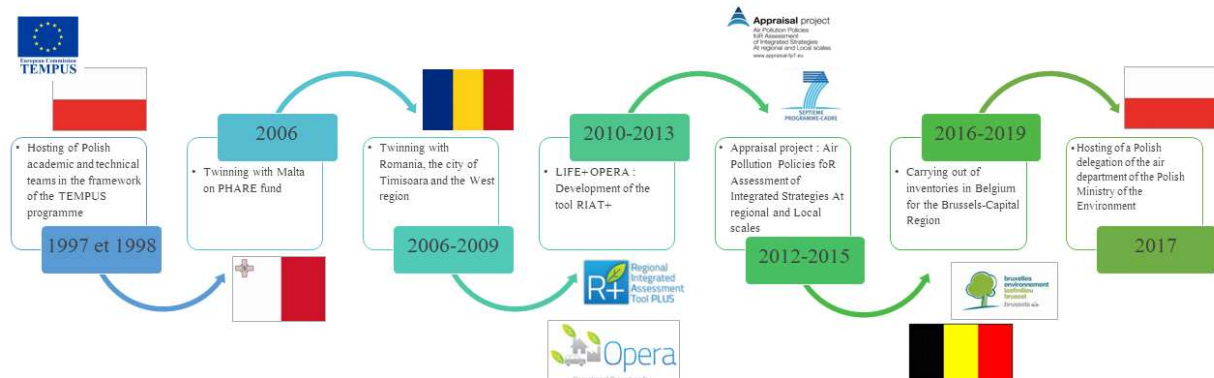
